- There are no refunds or reimbursements on payments made for classes you did not attend.
- You must notify us in writing if you plan to drop a class.
- There are no refunds on tuition payments; however, if we are notified of your schedule changes we can credit your account and move the tuition toward future payments.

BLACKBIRD DRESS CODE

Blackbird dancers are encouraged to wear what they feel the most comfortable dancing in, however, there are certain requirements that must be met in terms of dance clothing. All dancers must wear clothing that hugs the lines of the body and does not prevent them from any type of floor stretches or flexibility training. Females are required to wear leotards, tights, leggings, sports bras, etc. Males are required to wear t-shirts, tanks, gym shorts (with a dance belt or tights underneath) and/or jazz pants. No specific colors, types or brands are required. If you need help locating footwear or dancewear please feel free to ask about your options. **Hair must be pulled out of the face and secured during class. Ponytails or buns are ideal.**

Footwear Requirements

Ballet	Ballet slippers/NO SOCKS!
Jazz	Pirouettes, jazz shoe
Contemporary	Pirouettes, socks or bare feet
Hip Hop	Sneakers. NO white rubber soles allowed on our floors.
Tap	Tap shoes
